### Within 5 minutes of the Santa Fe Woman's Club

Hike up <u>Sun Mountain</u> for sunrise Catch the sunset at <u>Cross of the Martyrs Park</u> <u>Museum Hill</u> (Museum of Indian Arts & Culture, Museum of International Folk Art, Museum of Spanish Colonial Art) Walk around the <u>Santa Fe Botanical Garden</u> (\$12)

## If you have an hour

# If you have 2-3 hours
